	The writer acknowledges the opponent's viewpoint and uses a counterargument.	
ORGANIZATION	The essay starts with an interesting beginning, or hook. (i.e. anecdote, analogy, statistic, research, question, etc.)	
words to indicate cause-	Each paragraph of the paper has a topic sentence and supporting detail sentences that connect to each other in a logical order using appropriate transition words to indicate cause-and-effect, compare and contrast, opposing viewpoints, etc.	
	The writer concludes with a detailed summary linked to the purpose of the composition, and restates the thesis.	
LANGUAGE USE	The writer uses conditional statements and questions using if and auxiliary verbs would, will, might, must, can, could, should. (Ex: if you do this, you will)	
GE U	The writer uses a variety of sentence structures.	
SE	The writing has been edited for grammar, capitalization, punctuation, and indentation.
