
Simple Present Tense

SUBJECTS	AFFIRMATIVE (+)	NEGATIVE (-)	QUESTION (?)
I	I know.	I don't (do not) know.	Do I know?
YOU	You know.	You don't (do not) know.	Do you know?
WE	We know.	We don't (do not) know.	Do we know?
THEY	They know.	They don't (do not) know.	Do they know?
HE/SHE/IT	He knows.	He doesn't (does not) know.	Does he know?

Main Use:

We use simple present tense to talk about things that we always do or situations that occur in general.



- ⇒ The sun sets in the West.
- ⇒ The water boils at 100 degrees Celsius.
- ⇒ I go to school every week.
- ⇒ The fact that they don't visit us doesn't mean that they don't love us.

Simple present to talk about habits/hobbies

- ⇒ Every June we go to Florida for a vacation.
- ⇒ I brush my teeth every morning.
- ⇒ Bus comes at 3 o'clock.
